After finishing in the Top 10 on the show, she went on to perform around the country in the "So You Think You Can Dance Live Tour". Some of her additional, prominent television work includes being a featured dancer on CBS' "Dance Revolution" and Comcast's "Get Up and Dance". In Los Angeles, Shauna had the privilege of working in both the commercial and concert dance worlds. She was a featured dance soloist for 6 years for the prestigious company, "Unity LA", under the direction of Emmy award winning choreographer, Tessandra Chavez. She has also performed with "Soul Escape" under the direction of Justin Giles and with The Dance Company of San Francisco under the direction of Chris Jacobsen. Shauna has also always had a deep love for teaching and has taught and judged for many dance conventions and competitions around the world including: Hollywood Vibe, Jump, Shake the Floor, Celebrity, iHollywood, LaElite, and the Dance World Congress of Mexico. She also enjoys teaching master classes around the country as well as setting her own choreography. Shauna has been working as an award-winning choreographer for almost a decade. Most recently, she worked as an assistant choreographer under Tessandra Chavez with "Unity LA", on World of Dance Season 3.
